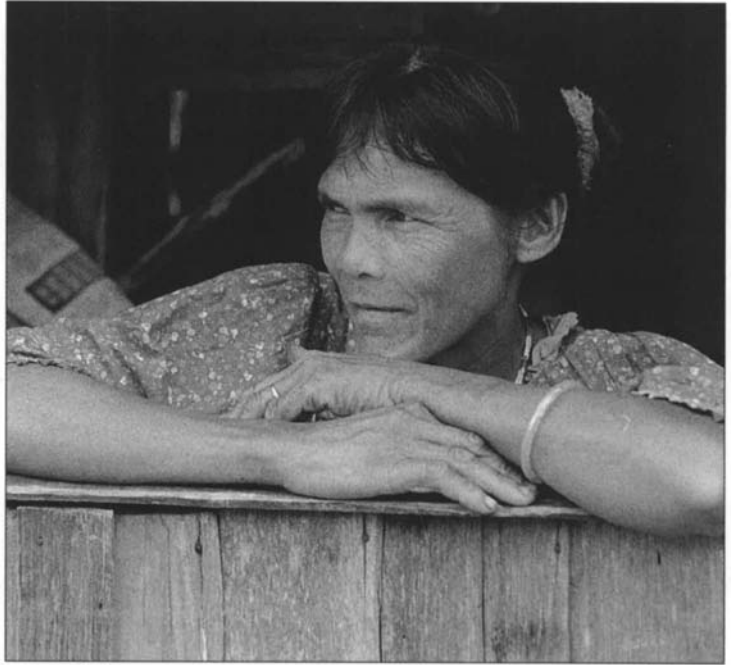

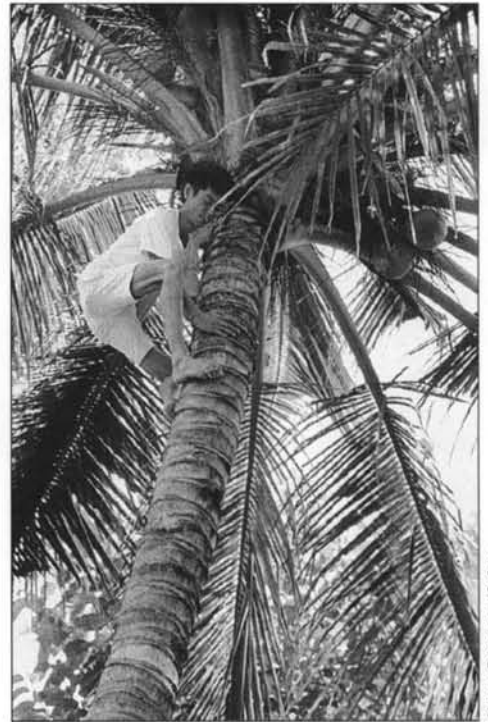
- Danao Bay. Palm-fringed beaches and coral sand make the Philippines a tourist paradise.
