<p>Play the role of... an 18-year-old girl. You live inside a UN base. You are harassed and attacked when you go to the latrines at night as there are no lights.</p>	<p>Play the role of... an international aid worker. You receive a good salary and live in a secure compound protected by security guards.</p>
<p>Play the role of... a newborn baby. Your parents are trying to give you the best future they can. You have food and shelter and people who care about you.</p>	<p>Play the role of... a woman living in a village with no water supply. Recently some armed men have come into the area and they won't let you get water from the nearest well.</p>

THE VULNERABILITY GAME

<p>Play the role of... an internally displaced person living in the UN camp in Bor. You are protected by UN soldiers inside the camp but you are attacked when you leave the camp to collect firewood. There is no other way of obtaining fuel for cooking.</p>	<p>Play the role of... a woman who lives in a UN base for protection. You sell tea in Malakal market during the day but you are harassed by armed men who steal the money from your business.</p>
<p>Play the role of... a refugee from South Sudan living in a camp in Ethiopia. You have no money, family or friends.</p>	<p>Play the role of... a rebel leader in control of an oil well in South Sudan's Unity State. You make a lot of money from selling oil and you have influential connections.</p>

<p>Play the role of... a man returning to South Sudan after independence. You have lived in the UK for 10 years, have a Ph.D from Oxford University and money to invest in new business opportunities.</p>	<p>Play the role of... the leader of South Sudan's rebel forces.</p>
<p>Play the role of... a businessman in Juba. You own several compounds rented to NGOs like Oxfam, but you have a big family to support.</p>	<p>Play the role of... a woman returning to her village from an IDP camp. You have essential items provided by the UN but your land and house have been taken by someone else.</p>

<p>Play the role of... a local government officer. You have influence and you can afford everything you need.</p>	<p>Play the role of... a woman displaced from her village and hiding in the forest. You forage for food and water and are very scared.</p>
<p>Play the role of... the President of South Sudan.</p>	<p>Play the role of... a 16 year old boy working on a teak plantation in Western Equatoria. You are given some food but no money. You have no family.</p>

THE VULNERABILITY GAME

Play the role of... a worker for a national human-rights NGO. You do a dangerous job and work very long hours for a small salary.

Play the role of... a soldier in the South Sudanese army, married with two children. You have not received your salary but with help from your family you are putting both your children through school.

Play the role of... a grandmother living in a UN displacement camp. You have lost your family and don't want to return to your village because there is nothing there for you. The camp has flooded in the rains and you don't have enough food to eat.

Play the role of... a cleaner at a UN peacekeepers' base. You receive a small salary plus the opportunity to get some extra luxuries like cigarettes and soft drinks

<p>Play the role of... a 14-year-old girl who is the head of her household with two younger sisters to support. You struggle to survive and make a small income in any way you can, including prostitution. You are regularly beaten by your clients and recently you have become very ill.</p>	<p>Play the role of... a farmer. Your fields are in a dangerous area and you risk being wounded or killed if you go there. If you don't work the fields your family will go hungry.</p>
<p>Play the role of... a disabled man from a minority ethnic group living in a village. You have no money or support and have to beg for food every day. You have been threatened by armed men in your village.</p>	<p>Play the role of... a married man with four children running a transport business in Juba. You have a good income and have saved some money. However recently two of your trucks have been stopped on the road by armed men, the drivers beaten and the goods stolen.</p>

THE VULNERABILITY GAME

<p>Play the role of... a humanitarian worker on a national contract with a UN agency. You have a good salary and can meet your family's basic needs.</p>	<p>Play the role of... a 10-year-old girl. You live in an orphanage in Wau and rarely have enough to eat. However the people who run the orphanage are kind and do not beat you.</p>
<p>Play the role of... a community leader from a dominant ethnic group with a rich and influential family. Recently you seized land belonging to members of the minority ethnic group, forcing them to flee in fear.</p>	<p>Play the role of... an asylum seeker in the UK. You have to work illegally as a labourer to repay the traffickers who brought you to the UK.</p>
