Lesson plan 3: Where does cotton grow?

Age group: 7 - 11

Aims:

To give practice in reading and using world maps.

What to do:

Ask children to look up in an atlas and mark on the outline map the following countries where cotton is grown:

Brazil; Sudan; China; Pakistan; Turkey; Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS), formerly the Soviet Union; Mexico; USA; Egypt; Tanzania; India; Zambia.
