Here is Ravi eating his lunch.



At half past twelve I go home for lunch. The little girl in this photograph is learning to make *injera*. This is a type of flat bread which we eat a lot in Ethiopia.





in a village in Ethiopia.




# What is Harika's day like?





9:30am




09:30



4:30pm



5:30pm


